1. Book Title and Author

2. Book Cover Illustration

Draw or print a picture of the book cover. You may also create your own version of the cover.

3. Setting

Describe where and when the story takes place. Write at least 3–5 complete sentences.

4. Main Characters

Choose 3–5 important characters. Include descriptions and explain why they are important.

5. Plot Summary

Write a summary using the beginning, middle, and end of the story.

6. Favorite Scene

Describe your favorite scene and explain why it stood out to you.

7. Theme or Lesson

Explain the lesson or message of the story.

8. Recommendation

Tell whether or not you would recommend this book to others and explain why.
